

## Developed improvements (1)




#### Developed improvements (2)



Feature to search for specific content within strings, to replace it:

- works with single and bulk actions
- use is independently from the Filter function
- further optional settings




**Single action**: switch to use a text editor instead of plain text:

much more easy editing of text (especially with html-tags)



# Developed improvements (3)



#### **Bulk actions for multiple editing of customisations:**

- Replace content
- Remove selected "Local customisation"
- Copy+paste the "Standard text" to "Local customisation"



#### Planned improvements

- Acceptance tests for automated testing
- Use of text editor with less functionality (for better use)
- Download of selected customisation
