



Only closed questions


- Multiple choice

- Calculated
- Calculated simple
- Drag and drop into text
- Drag and drop markers


- Drag and drop onto image
- Kprime (ETH)
- Multiple True False (ETH)
- Select missing words
- Single Choice (ETH) with limited informative value, since it is not possible for responses that were excluded (crossed out; scoring method Aprime or Subpoints).





The closer a question to the line, the more it's quality is low


Shows which options
