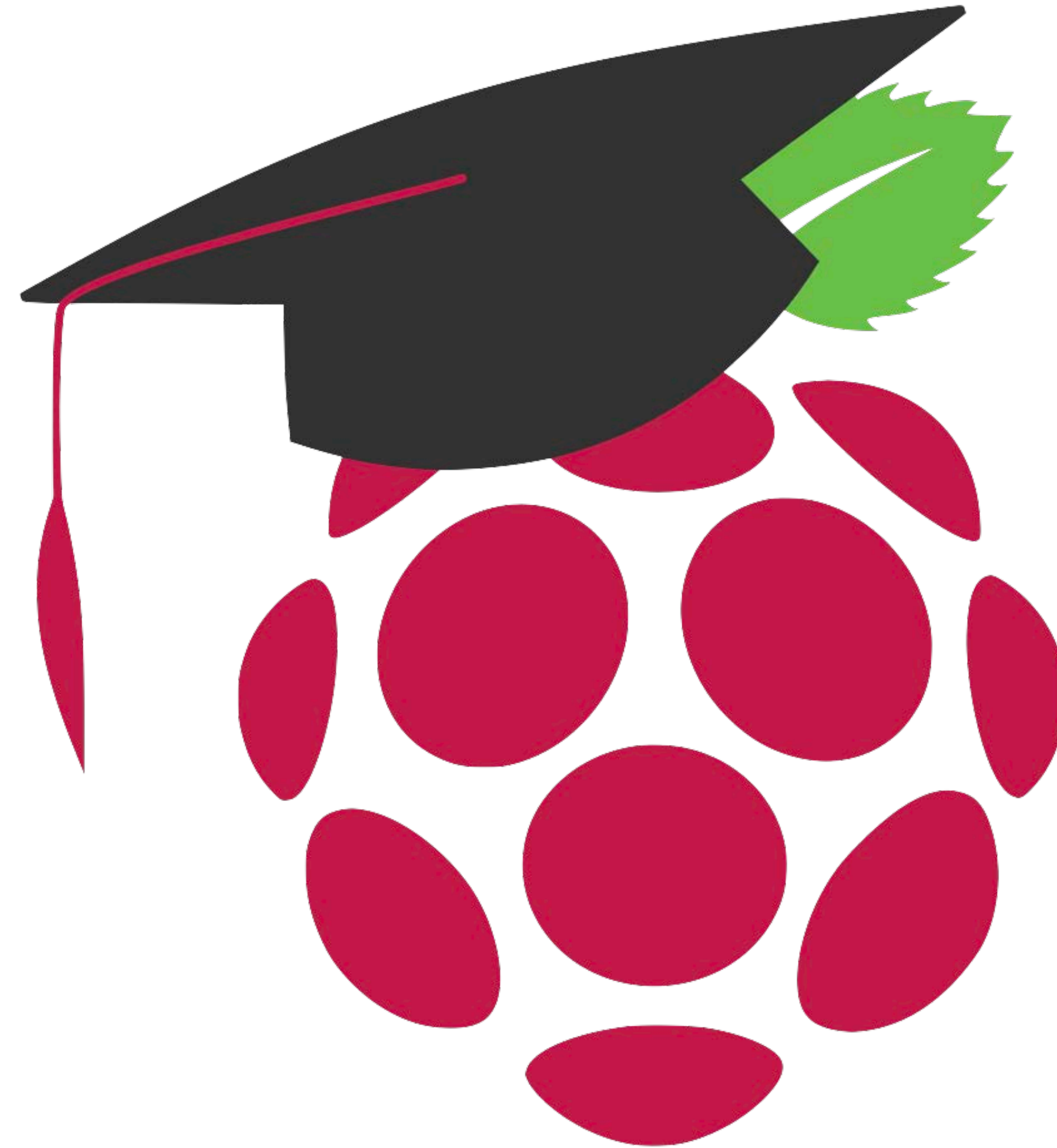

Using Moodle when the infrastructure does not allow a server or when there is no proper Internet connection

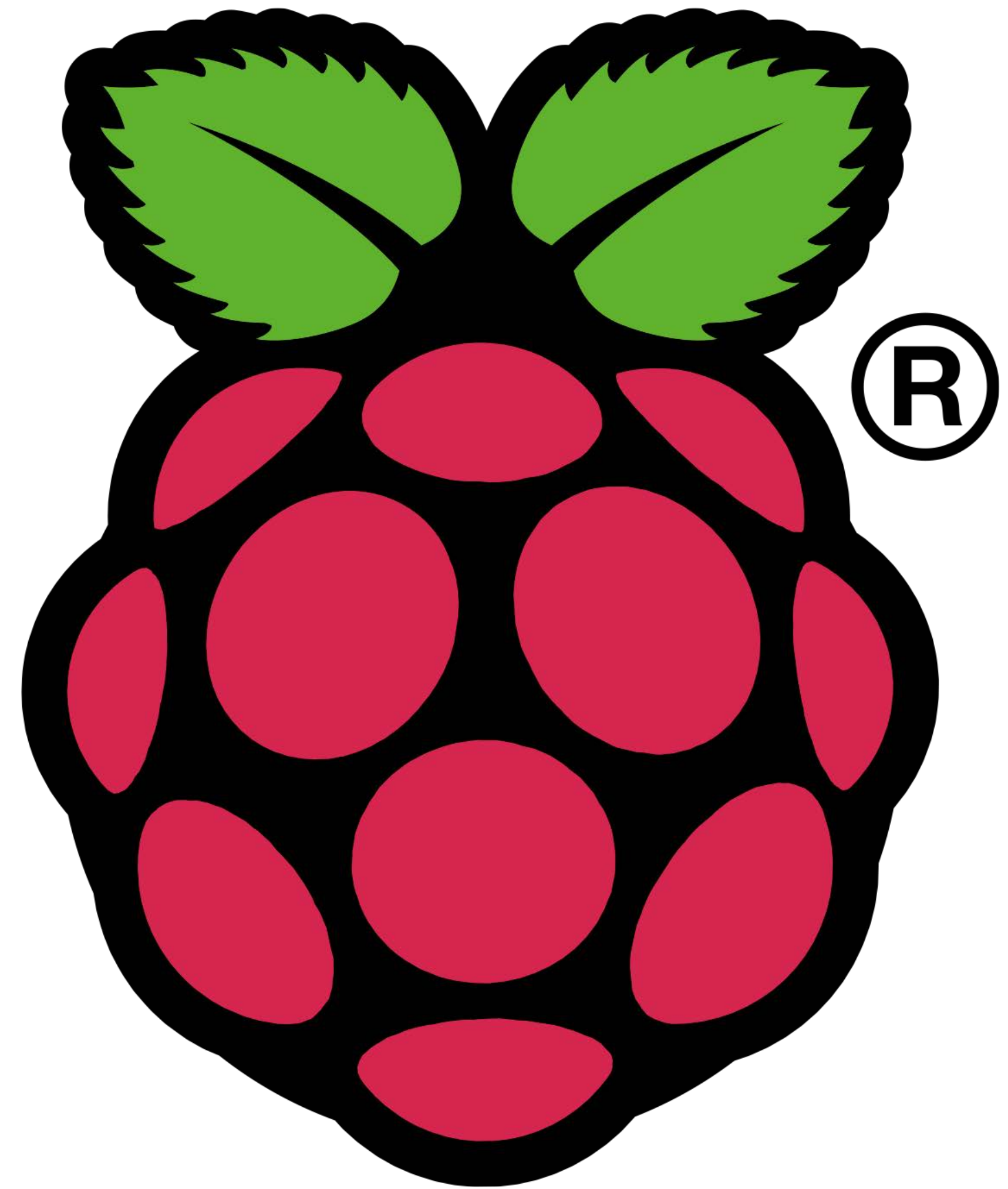
Vision of MoodleBox

A standalone, all-in-one, small, cheap and plug-and-play mobile device which combines a wireless access point with a fully featured Moodle server

Free software under an open source license

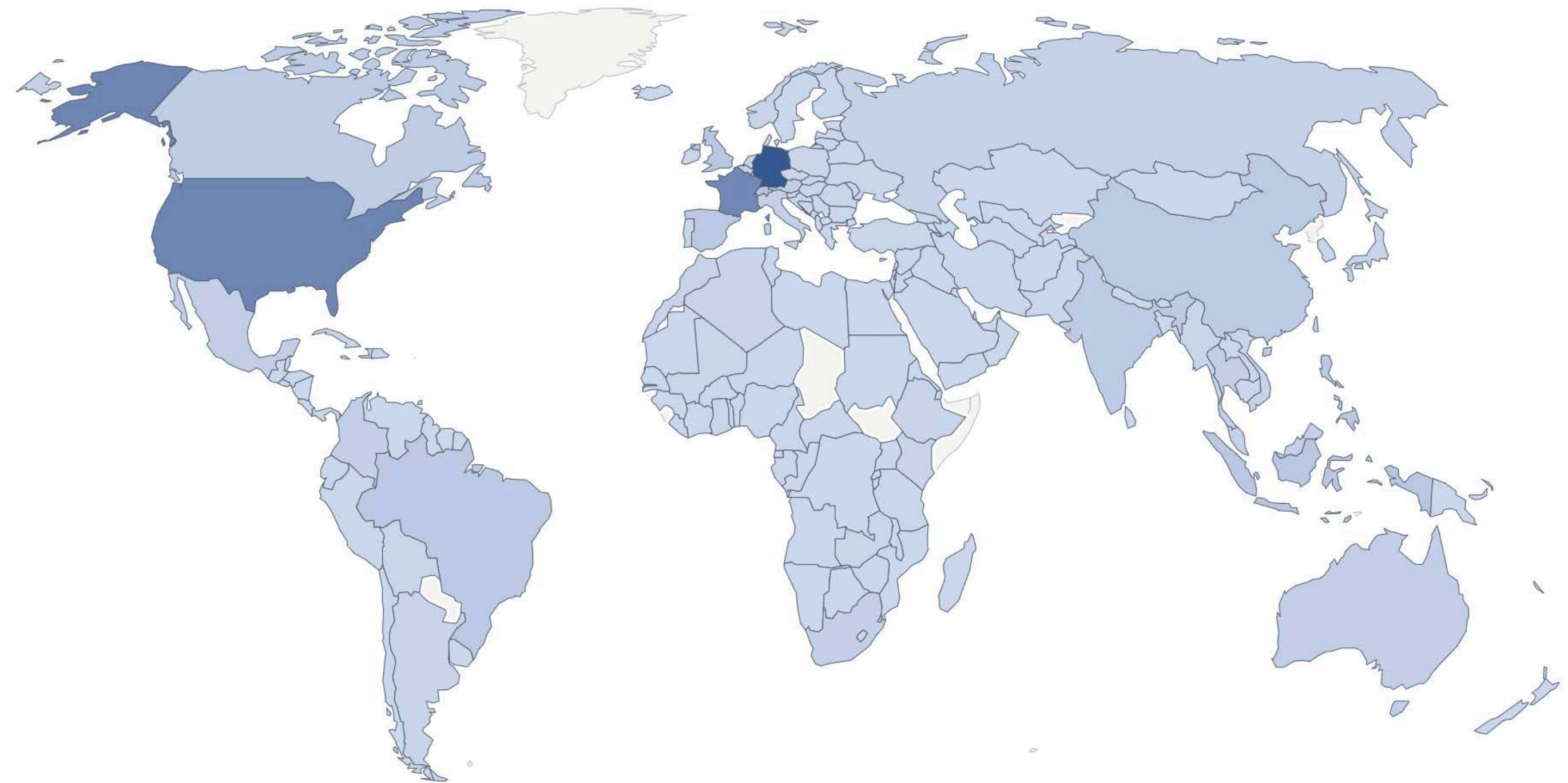
MoodleBox criteria

- Small and mobile
- Cheap
- Standalone
- All-in-one
- Moodle server
- Client access via Wi-Fi



Use of the MoodleBox in the World

- MoodleBox image was downloaded more than 30,000 times !
- MoodleBox is used on all continents, and almost in all countries in the World



A few MoodleBox use cases

- Digital learning platform for Syrian refugee girls, Lebanon
- Moodle in the wild: e-learning in the wilderness for teacher training, Germany
- Moodle in prison: at the Caen detention centre, France, inmates have access to course content from the local university
- Rural literacy solutions, Ghana
- Escape game for chemistry teaching at the Troyes University of Technology, France
- Reaching remote areas with interactive school digital resources with no Internet and no reliable electricity, Lebanon
- And many more...

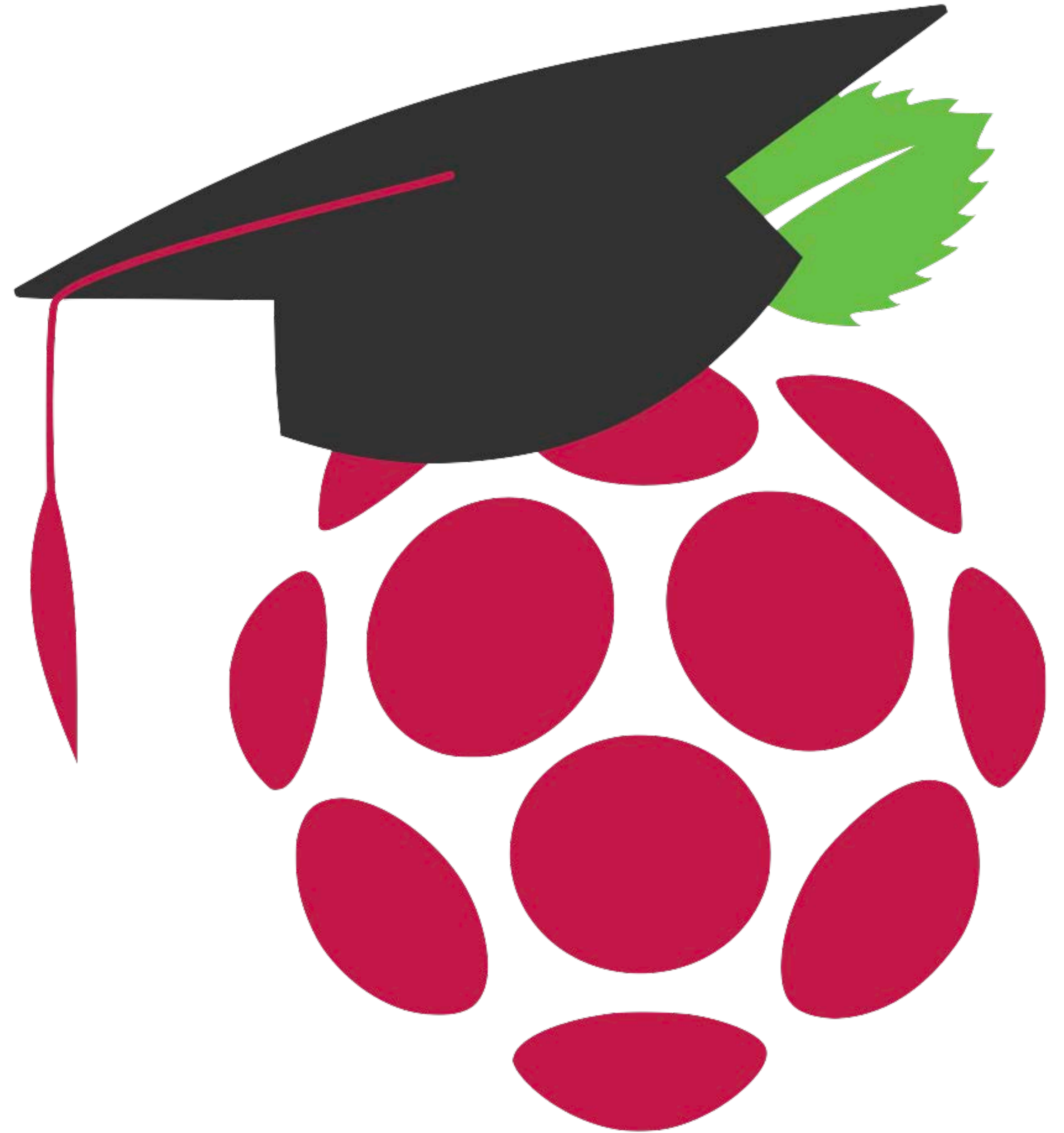
MoodleBox: the onion model

1. Hardware
2. Software (prepared disk image + Moodle plugin)
3. Support and documentation
4. Content (preferably OER)
